Student Members: All individuals who have attained the age of 18 years and are enrolled as posteraduate students in an academic institution or of AIMA for its diploma program shall be eligible for student membership. Application for student membership shall have to be forwarded by the Head of the Department/Institution in which the candidate has enrolled himself or herself as a student.
